<u>Session Description</u>: Over the past two years, the Federal Reserve has raised rates faster than at any point in the past 40+ years. Some parts of the economy, such as the labor market and consumer spending, are holding up. Other areas, such as the housing market and manufacturing sector, are not. In this session, Wells Fargo Economist Shannon Seery will unpack our latest thinking in terms of what to expect from the Federal Reserve and what that means for the broader national economy and for Western New York.
